There are various stands of timber on the property. Some of which have been planted and others of which are natural growth stands. There is a survey on file for the property as well as two points of access coming in from Highway 241 that are deeded. There are also maps showing the different stands of timber and when they were planted along with their acreage.

There are numerous places where tree stands and ground blinds can be situated to make this a fantastic hunting property. Plenty of deer and turkey are on the property and with some management this can really be a turn-key hunting tract. Road systems can easily be cut and maintained throughout the property for access to use while hunting or riding ATVs. This is also a great place to build home on ample acreage or place a secluded hunting cabin or weekend getaway. Not only is Duplin County known for its dense whitetail deer and wild turkey population, there is an ample amount of black bear. The diverse ages of the planted pines offer a few possibilities in regards to future income. Stands of timber can be managed (harvested, thinned, replanted) at various stages of growth. This provides a source of income that is staggered for many years. The ages and acreages of the stands of timber are below:

109.08 acres of planted loblolly pines that were planted in 1998.

163.94 acres of planted loblolly pines that were planted in 2020.

34.51 acres of natural loblolly pines dated back to 1947.

16.05 acres of planted loblolly pines that were planted in 1998

13.66 acres of hardwood swamp dated back to 1947

From the property you are 10 minutes from Beulaville and 5 minutes from Pink Hill. Pink Hill (https://www.townofpinkhill.com) is to the North of the property and Beulaville (http://www.townofbeulaville.com) is to the South of the property.
