There is also a path that goes through the property that is in very good shape and is 30-40 feet wide (see photo gallery). The property is accessed via a 30 foot deeded access easement that has been surveyed and recorded. A copy of the easement is available upon request. This property is locked and gated so please don't visit the property without an agent present.

There have been a number of deer and black bear spotted on the property. There are plenty of places where feeders, food plots, and hunting blinds can be situated to allow ample hunting opportunities. With some clearing work, additional paths and trails can be made to access more of the interior of the property. The neighboring tracts of land consists of family farms and large tracts of timberland, making this a great place to enjoy nature and wildlife on an easy to manage tract of land.

Fort Barnwell is an unincorporated community in Craven County, North Carolina, United States. The fort was founded by Colonel John Barnwell of the South Carolina militia in 1712, and was abandoned in 1715. The fort, used in the Tuscarora War is now an archeological site and a National Historic Landmark. The present-day town of Fort Barnwell is located 18 miles east of Kinston and 2 miles west of New Bern near the Neuse River. Highway 55 runs through the town. It receives mail through the Dover Post Office and is served by the Fort Barnwell Volunteer Fire Department.
