Situated along NC 130/US 501, lies 23-acre Parcel #1 of the Wilkinson Creek Tract in rural Robeson County. This tract contains 12 acres of high and dry agriculture field with 1,110 feet of road frontage along NC 130/US 501 and then a 11-acre balance containing mature pine, hardwood, and then grading to the run of Wilkinson Creek with historic cypress and gum throughout. Tract of land is perfect for a buyer looking for a place to build a home or a place to grow row crops and raise a head of cattle or horses right behind their home. Rear of property backs up to Wilkinson Creek and an unnamed tributary that provides a solid, natural barrier between adjoining landowners. Area is well known for big bucks and long bearded turkeys, but the stretch along Wilkinson Creek at the rear of the property contains open water with emergent, aquatic vegetation that is prime waterfowl habitat to- attract both migrant and resident duck flocks. This section of Robeson County is well known for high production dove hunts and the fields could be planted in sunflowers and corn to bring them in by the thousands. Surrounding parcels are located in similar forested and agriculture parcels rich in wildlife, including deer, turkey, waterfowl, and small game. Tract has direct access to NC 130/US 501 with over 1,100 foot of road frontage! It's the perfect tract to live on and hunt out the back door for both big and small game in the South. Tract is easily accessible to major highways for quick access to neighboring municipalities. The tract is just a few miles outside of Rowland, less than 20 minutes from Lumberton, 20 minutes from Laurinburg, only 1 1/2 hours from Myrtle Beach and Wilmington, and 2 hours from Raleigh and Charlotte.-

The high ground is currently-enrolled in active agriculture operations with rotations of soybeans and corn. Agriculture fields are dominated by Norfolk and Wagram Loamy Sands.- The agriculture land is very fertile offering excellent agriculture returns or possible conversion to a longleaf pine straw raking operation with long term timber opportunities. The majority of woodlands are dominated by mature hardwoods with inclusions of towering loblolly pine trees offering the potential for immediate income earnings on existing stands.- Deer and turkey tracks dominate the field perimeter from the incidental spillage from recent agriculture harvests. If farming, hunting, or making money off the land is what makes you happy, this tract may very well end your land search today.
