23.4 acres of the pines have been placed in a 30 year CREP program that matures in 2033, the stands are currently 20 years of age, in excellent condition and been managed in accordance with the program. The property borders adjoining farm fields on four sides and has an excellent path system that allows easy access to the entire tract. This property has everything you need, privacy, excellent food sources for wild game and plenty of room for multiple hunters to enjoy safely.
